



## HALF-MOON OUTFITTERS NORTH CHARLESTON, SC

**T**he Half-Moon Outfitters' new Distribution Center is a renovated, one-story, 9,800 square foot combined office and warehouse. The building was originally built in 1940 as a grocery store and was most recently a transmission parts store. The renovation began in early 2006 and was completed in December of the same year. The new Half-Moon corporate office and warehouse has been given the US Green Building Council's LEED Platinum award. The LEED rating system recognizes projects for having sustainable site conditions, selecting environmentally preferred materials, providing a healthy indoor environment, and using water and energy efficiently. Half-Moon becomes only the nation's 25th new construction or major renovation to receive a Platinum rating and is the very first to do so using the newer, more stringent LEED NC version 2.2. It is also the first LEED Platinum project in the state of South Carolina.
